The redemption scenario above neglects early redemption.

If the Final Fixing Level of all Underlyings trades above the Knock-in Level, the redemption equals 100.00% of Denomination (CHF 5'000). In these cases, the performance of the product corresponds to the sum of the guaranteed Coupons paid out during the lifetime: 7.5000%.

If the Final Fixing Level of at least one Underlying trades at or below the Knock-in Level, the performance equals the percentual difference between the Cap Level and the Closing Price on the Final Fixing Date of the worst performing Underlying. Therefore, the investor may suffer a partial or total loss. This negative performance is reduced by the guaranteed Coupons paid out during the lifetime of the product. The Coupon Payment occurs independently of the level of the Underlyings on the respective Coupon Observation Date.

The table above is valid at maturity only and is by no means meant as a price indication for these structured products throughout its lifetime. If an extraordinary event as described in the base prospectus occurs in relation to the Underlying/a component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event.
