Redemption method

Early Redemption

Early Redemption depends on the value of the Underlyings on the respective Observation Date.

- If the closing price of all Underlyings on the Observation Date is at or above the Call Level, the product will be redeemed early at 100% of Denomination.
- If at least one Underlying closes below the Call Level on the Observation Date, the product continues.

Redemption at maturity

If no Early Redemption event has occurred, the following redemption scenarios are possible:

- If the Final Fixing Value of all Underlyings is at or above the Cap Level, the Redemption amounts to 100% of Denomination.
- If the Final Fixing Value of one or more Underlyings is below the Cap Level, the investor receives a physical delivery of the worst performing Underlying (between Initial Fixing Date and Final Fixing Date). The number of Underlyings per Denomination is defined in Ratio (fractions will be paid in cash, no cumulation).

The Coupons are paid out on the respective Coupon Date independent of the performance of the Underlyings.

Key elements of the product

The ZKB Autocallable Reverse Convertible on worst of is an investment product, which can be redeemed early quarterly - depending on the performance of the Underlyings. The product regularly pays out attractive Coupons during the term. This product is a combined investment instrument that essentially consists of a fixed income security and the sale of a "out-of-the-money" put option. This allows the investor to benefit from the current volatility of the Underlyings. An above-average return is achieved when prices fall slightly, stagnate or rise slightly. If the Final Fixing Value of all Underlyings is at or above the Cap Level, the investor receives a cash redemption in the amount of the Denomination. If the Final Fixing Value of at least one Underlying is below the Cap Level, the investor will receive a physical delivery of a number of Underlyings as defined under "Redemption method" of the Underlying with the worst performance between Initial Fixing Date and Final Fixing Date.

Taxes

The product is considered as transparent and has no predominant one-off interest (Non-IUP). The Coupon of 1.9527% (7.8109% p.a.) is divided into a premium payment of 1.9527% (7.8109% p.a.) and an interest payment of 0.00% (0.00% p.a.). The option premium part qualifies as capital gain and is not subject to Swiss income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile. The interest payment is subject to income tax at the time of payment. The Swiss withholding tax is levied. In the case of physical delivery of the Underlying at maturity, the federal securities transfer stamp is levied on the basis of the Cap level. The Federal securities transfer stamp tax is levied on secondary market transactions. The redemption scenario above neglects early redemption.

If the Final Fixing Value of all Underlyings is at or above the Cap Level, the performance of the product is always given by the Coupons paid out during the term (acc. "Coupon Dates"), in this case 15.6216%. However, if the Final Fixing Value of at least one Underlying is below the Cap Level, the investor will receive a physical delivery of a number of Underlyings as defined in Ratio. Therefore, the investor may suffer a partial or total loss. The acquisition price of the delivered Underlyings is 73.00% of the Initial Fixing Value, which means that the performance of the product is less negative than the performance of the Underlying. This negative performance is reduced by the guaranteed Coupons paid out during the term.

The table above is valid at maturity only and is by no means meant as a price indication for the present product throughout its lifetime. Additional risk factors may have a significant impact on the value of the product during the term. The price quoted on the secondary market can therefore deviate substantially from the above table. For this table it was assumed, that Adecco Group AG rs was the worst performing Underlying. This selection is just a representative example of the possible alternatives. 3. Material Risks for Investors

Issuer Risk

Obligations under these structured products constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the structured product not only depends on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this structured product.

Specific product risks

The loss potential of an investment in ZKB Autocallable Reverse Convertibles on worst of in the case of a title delivery is limited to the difference between the purchase price of the product and the cumulative value of the number of Underlyings as defined in 'Redemption Method'. The Coupon, which is paid out in any case, reduces the loss of the product compared to a direct investment in the worst performing Underlying. The price of the Underlyings may be significantly below the Cap Level at redemption.

Modifications
