Key Elements of the product

ZKB Capital Protection Note with Participation is an investment product which combines the purchase of an „at-the-money“ call option and a bond investment. The investor participates at the Participation Rate in any increase in the Underlying from the Exercise Price on. In addition, the Capital Protection guarantees the Minimum Redemption, which is independent of the price behaviour of the Underlying.

Taxes

The product is considered as transparent and IUP (Intérêt Unique Prédominant). The implied internal rate of return is subject to income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile at sale or maturity (IRR 1.70% p.a., present value of bond part at issue 95.08%) and is determined in compliance with the "modifizierte Differenzbesteuerung" tax rule based on the ESTV Bondfloor Pricing method. Any return derived from the option part qualifies as capital gain and is not subject to Swiss income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile. The product is not subject to Swiss withholding tax. The Federal securities transfer stamp tax is levied on secondary market transactions for securities with initial duration of less than one year. 3. Material Risks for Investors

Issuer Risk

Obligations under this structured product constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the structured product not only depends on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this structured product.

Specific Product Risks

4. Additional Terms

Modifications

If an extraordinary event as described in the base prospectus occurs in relation to the Underlying/a component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event. Specific modification rules for certain types of Underlyings stated in the base prospectus shall prevail. If the Issuer determines, for whatever reason, that an adequate modification is not possible, the Issuer has the right to redeem the products early.

Change of Obligor
