1. Product Description

This product does not constitute a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Swiss Federal Act on Collective Investment Schemes (CISA) and it is not subject to authorisation or supervision by FINMA. The issuer risk is borne by investors.

The composition of the Underlying of this structured product is managed dynamically and **discretionary** over the course of its term.

The investment manager selects stocks along the entire value chain of electric vehicles and their batteries, which should benefit from the already emerging boom in the electrification of road transport. The basket composition offers solutions in the areas of metals & chemicals for battery production, batteries and semiconductors, electric vehicles and charging infrastructure and has a very attractive risk-return profile from a fundamental valuation perspective.

Key Elements of the product

In terms of value, buying a ZKB Tracker Certificate Dynamic is equivalent to buying the Underlying less any Fees. A single, low-cost transaction gives investors the opportunity to participate fully in the performance of the Underlying. Dividend Payments of underlying components in the basket are paid out to the investor by means of Dividend reinvestment in the Underlying. Redemption is based on the weighted value of Underlying components on the Fixing Date.

Taxes

The Issuer reports the taxable factors (change to previous year's value) divided in the components income and capital gain to the Swiss Federal Tax Administration on 31 October each year. The income part is subject to Swiss income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile as per reporting date. The capital gain part is not subject to Swiss income tax. The product is not subject to Swiss withholding tax. The Federal securities transfer stamp tax is not levied on secondary market transactions. 3. Material Risks for Investors

Issuer Risk

Obligations under these structured products constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the structured product does not only depend on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this structured product.

Specific Product Risks

Structured products are complex financial instruments, which entail considerable risks and, accordingly, are only suitable for investors who have the requisite knowledge and experience and understand thoroughly the risks connected with an investment in these structured products and are capable of bearing the economic risks.

ZKB Tracker Certificate Dynamic is an investment product whose price fluctuates to the same degree as the Underlying less any Fees. Depending on price trends, the price of a ZKB Tracker Certificate Dynamic could fall below the Issue Price. The risk profile of the ZKB Tracker Certificate Dynamic corresponds to that of the Underlying. The ZKB Tracker Certificate Dynamic is denominated in CHF. The investor bears all the risks in connection with a possible exchange rate risk between the product currency, the currency of the components of the Underlying, and his reference currency.

Investments with regard to Emerging Markets are exposed to several risk factors especially political or economic risks. The political system, the continuity and the political culture of emerging markets might be totally different compared to developed countries and might therefore cause a negative influence on the Underlying and/or the currencies. Specific modification rules for certain types of Underlyings stated in the base prospectus shall prevail. If the Issuer determines, for whatever reason, that an adequate modification is not possible, the Issuer has the right to redeem the products early.

During the term of the structured product, changes in or substitution of the Underlying by the Calculation Agent can occur.
