ZKB Capital Protection Note with Participation on worst of is an investment product which combines the purchase of a worst of "at the money" call option and a bond investment. At Maturity the investor participates in the positive performance of the worst performing Underlying (from the Exercise Price) to the extent of the participation rate shown. In addition, the specified capital protection guarantees a Minimum Redemption Amount at expiry, which is paid out regardless of the performance of the Underlyings, as well as a guaranteed Fixed Coupon, which is paid out regardless of the performance of the Underlyings.

Taxes

The product is considered as transparent and IUP (Intérét Unique Prédominant). The implied internal rate of return is subject to income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile at sale or maturity (IRR 1.35% ** p.a., present value of bond part at issue 94.68% **) and is determined in compliance with the "modifizierte Differenzbesteuerung" tax rule based on the ESTV Bondfloor Pricing method. Zürcher Kantonalbank Finance (Guernsey) Limited does not have a rating.

The loss potential of an investment in ZKB Capital Protection Note with Participation and Coupon is limited at maturity to the difference between the purchase price and the Minimum Redemption Amount. Nevertheless, during the lifetime of the product, the ZKB Capital Protection Note with Participation and Coupon may trade at a lower value than the Minimum Redemption Amount guaranteed per maturity.

Modifications
