Key Elements of the product

In terms of value, buying a ZKB Tracker Certificate is equivalent to buying the Underlying. A single, low-cost transaction gives investors the opportunity to participate fully in the performance of the Underlying. The dividend payments from the Underlying components that are expected during the lifetime of the structured product are discounted at Issue Date. Redemption is based on the weighted value of Underlying components on the Final Fixing Date.

Taxes

For private investors with Swiss tax domicile, the dividend discount is subject to Swiss income tax at maturity. The product is not subject to Swiss withholding tax. The Federal securities transfer stamp tax is not levied on secondary market transactions. This product may be subject to additional withholding taxes or duties, such as related to FATCA, Sect. 871(m) U.S. Tax Code or foreign financial transaction taxes. 3. Material Risks for Investors

Issuer Risk

Obligations under these structured products constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the structured product does not only depend on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this structured product.

Specific Product Risks

Structured products are complex financial instruments, which entail considerable risks and, accordingly, are only suitable for investors who have the requisite knowledge and experience and understand thoroughly the risks connected with an investment in these structured products and are capable of bearing the economic risks.

ZKB Tracker Certificate is an investment product whose price fluctuates to the same degree as the Underlying. Depending on price trends, the price of a ZKB Tracker Certificate could fall below the Issue Price. The risk profile of the ZKB Tracker Certificate corresponds to that of the Underlying. The ZKB Tracker Certificate is denominated in CHF. If the investor's reference currency differs from the CHF, the investor bears the risk between the CHF and his reference currency.

4. Additional Terms

Modifications

If an extraordinary event as described in the base prospectus occurs in relation to the Underlying/a component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event. Specific modification rules for certain types of Underlyings stated in the base prospectus shall prevail. If the Issuer determines, for whatever reason, that an adequate modification is not possible, the Issuer has the right to redeem the products early.

Substitution of Underlying

During the term of the structured product, changes in or substitution of the Underlying by the Calculation Agent can occur. In this case, it cannot be ruled out that such changes or substitutions will negatively affect the value of the structured product. Likewise, it cannot be ruled out that in the case of a structured product based on an index that changes in the composition of the index as a result of change or substitutions in respect of individual index components, for example, as a result of the withdrawal or addition of individual securities, may negatively influence the price of the index and accordingly the value of the structured product.
